We offer more than 24 degree and certificate programs across medicine, nursing, allied health and biomedical research; more than 60 postgraduate training programs for medical residents and fellows; and continuing education options.

The Enrollment-At-A-Glance Report provides five-year data that include the total student headcount, headcount for newly enrolled students, student demographics, and degrees awarded. The report is updated each term.

Enrollment data are obtained from the Student Information System and are based on the official Census Date established by the Registrar. The Census Date is the date on which enrollment counts are frozen for purposes of internal and external reporting. The Census Date for Fall 2024 was September 12th. Students not registered in the Student Information System by September 12th may not be included in the count for that term. This report also includes the Fall 2024 budgeted vs. actual enrollments obtained from the University Finance Team.

Total Student Headcount by College and Program

- Fall 2024 total headcount **decreased by less than 1%** compared to Fall 2023, from 2782 to 2769.
 - **Greatest % decreases** occurred in the Speech Language Pathology, MS (-19%, -14 students); Clinical Laboratory Management, MS (-10%, -4 students); Health Sciences, BS (-10%, -5 students); and Health Sciences, PhD (-9%, -5 students) programs.
 - **Greatest % increases** occurred in the Post-Graduate Nursing, Cert (44%, +4 students); Specialist in Blood Bank Technology, Cert (38%, +3 students); Imaging Sciences, BS (24%, +12 students); Respiratory Care, MS (15%, +5 students) and Health Systems Management, MS (14%, +13 students) programs.
- The College of Nursing accounted for **43%** of the total Fall 2024 enrollments, followed by the College of Health Sciences (30%), Rush Medical College (25%), and Non-Degree Seeking (2%).
- Undergraduates comprised **5%** of the total student population; MS/MSN programs **31%**; professional doctorates **56%**; research doctorates **5%**; certificates **1%**; and non-degree seeking or Students-at-Large **2%**.
- Though overall enrollment has decreased, there was an increase in undergraduate enrollment (+14%, +17 students).

Total Student Headcount by Demographics

- Gender distribution and average age have remained steady since 2020, with **78%** female and **22%** male. The average age of the student body is 30 years.
- The proportion of all racial minority students has steadily increased since 2020. Approximately **46% of the student population are racial minorities**, with about 27% of the student population classified as an underrepresented minority.
- Between 2021 and 2024, the proportion of Black/African American students has **consistently increased by about 1%**, now accounting for 11% of the total student population. The Fall 2024 enrollment of Black/African American students increased over Fall 2023, from 281 to 305.
- The proportion of Hispanic students has increased from **12%** (n=347) in 2020 to **16%** (n=440) in 2024. Fall 2024 Hispanic student enrollment **increased by 1%** from 414 to 440.

Degrees Awarded

- **The University awarded 944 degrees during the 2023-2024 academic year**, a **1%** increase over the 2022-2023 academic year. Compared to the 2020-2021 academic year, this is an increase of 15% (from 815 to 944); some of this increase is believed to be delayed graduation as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Budgeted vs. Actual Fall 2024 Enrollments

- Overall, **the University met its budgeted enrollment target** for Fall 2024.
- The College of Health Sciences and the College of Nursing each met their Fall 2024 projected enrollments.

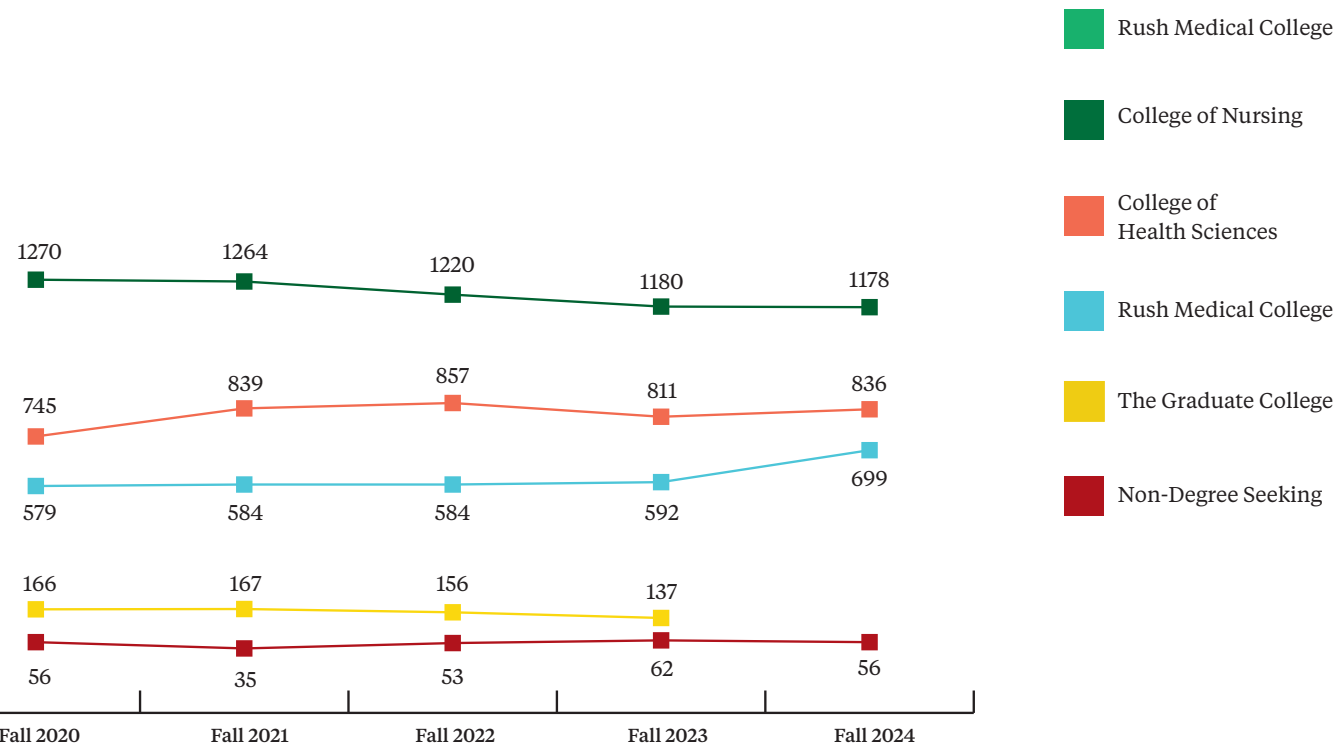
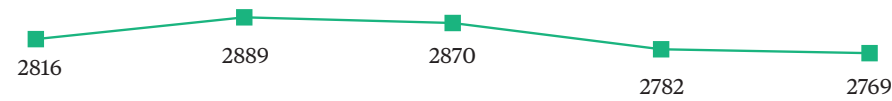

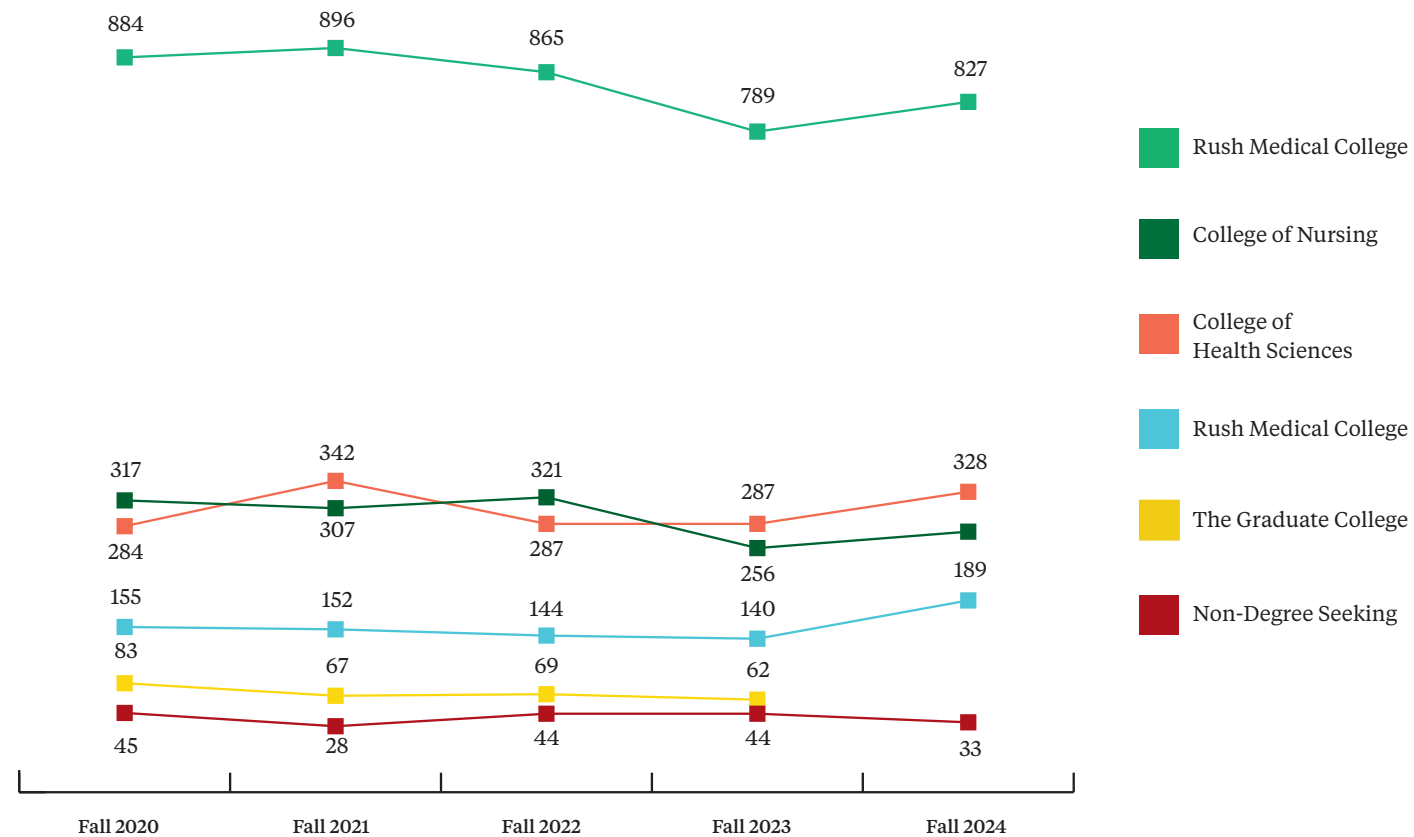
